Academic Regalia

The black robes of the faculty and the graduates are based upon clothing worn by clerics in medieval times. In the same manner as the skilled trades, the students and teachers of many medieval universities organized into guilds. A distinctive style of robe became traditional for Bachelors (apprentices), Masters (teachers), and Doctors (teachers who had completed postgraduate studies). Seminaries and universities design their own unique regalia. Therefore, you will see a variety of styles and colours worn by our faculty.

Recognition of Academic Honours

Heritage Baptist College and Heritage Theological Seminary award their degrees with special recognition. These honours are bestowed by the faculty upon students who have earned at least a 3.50 accumulated grade point average (AGPA). The cords normally worn by the students designate the level of academic honours achieved.

Cords	AGPA	Honours
White	3.50 – 3.74	cum laude (<i>with praise</i>)
Red	3.75 – 3.90	magna cum laude (<i>with high praise</i>)
Gold	3.91 – 4.00	summa cum laude (<i>with highest praise</i>)
