At this crucial time, Heritage College & Seminary is uniquely and strategically situated to serve churches, denominations, and mission agencies. At Heritage, we help Christians major in the Word of God, so they can help churches make a world of difference in Canada and throughout the world.

Our commitment to the authority of Scripture and the sufficiency of the gospel, coupled with a highly qualified and experienced faculty, allows us to train pastors and ministry leaders who will strengthen local churches and spread the gospel to Canada and the nations.

Heritage College & Seminary has launched a capital campaign to raise funds for a dedicated seminary building along with several other projects.

The new building will provide a **home** for our seminary, a **hub** for local churches and a place of **hope** for the community.

We are planning to **enlarge our campus, extend our ministry, and expand our reach.**





ENLARGE OUR CAMPUS

A NEW HOME FOR HERITAGE THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY (\$14,000,000)

Our seminary enrolment has grown significantly, and our current facilities are at capacity.

A new seminary building will provide much-needed space and raise the profile of the seminary within the Heritage community. This new facility will contain connected classrooms for live and livestream instruction, inviting places to study or gather over a cup of coffee, a Global Outreach Centre, an auditorium for conferences and banquets, as well as ample faculty offices.

This new home will allow Heritage Theological Seminary to teach and mentor more pastors and leaders dedicated to strengthening the church in our nation and spreading the gospel to all nations.

As of printing, God has provided through individual donors, churches corporations and estate gifts, pledges and donations totalling \$13,348,000.



CAMPAIGN COSTS (\$100,000)

These funds are used to cover the costs of events, promotional materials and videos, campaign marketing, and other related expenses.

CAMPUS IMPROVEMENTS AND TECHNOLOGY UPGRADES (\$400,000)

To make our campus more welcoming, we plan to upgrade the current property with landscaping, sidewalks, and energy-efficient LED lighting. To make our facilities accessible for all our guests and students we plan to install an elevator in our current academic building. To deliver the highest quality training, both to students on campus and those at a distance, we will upgrade and expand our computer systems and capabilities.





EXTEND OUR MINISTRY

MULTIPLY OUR SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS (\$300,000)

To send more biblically equipped men and women into the mission of Christ in the world, we aimed to significantly expand our scholarship program. We desire to help students complete their studies without accumulating heavy financial debt. *We praise God for His provision of this need through a generous estate gift.*

EXTEND OUR DISTANCE LEARNING OPTIONS AND NEW GRADUATE AND MINISTRY CERTIFICATES (\$180,000)

Through the development of our on-line programs, Heritage provides quality biblical education options for men and women wherever they live. We now offer full undergraduate certificate and degree programs online as well as our MTS and MDiv degrees online. We plan to introduce new program offerings, including a graduate certificate in church planting, a graduate certificate in community chaplaincy, teaching TESOL for ministry outreach and new ministry certificate programs. *We are grateful to God for providing for this project.*

SUPPORT FOR OUR FACULTY & STAFF (\$200,000)

Our greatest asset as a school is the committed faculty and staff who serve Christ and His Church at Heritage. *We praise God for His provision for this project.*

ENHANCE OUR LIBRARY (\$100,000)

To provide excellent academic support to our students, faculty, and graduates, we will upgrade and enhance our library for today's learning environments. This includes providing online digitized catalogues, journals, and books for both our resident and distance learning students. *We praise God for His provision of this need through an anticipated estate gift.*





EXPAND OUR REACH

LAUNCH THE GLOBAL OUTREACH CENTRE (\$60,000)

Out of a desire to spread the gospel to the nations, we are launching a Global Outreach Centre from our new seminary building. This GO Centre will be a catalyst to encourage Heritage students to take part in local outreach and global missions. It will also assist local churches in raising their engagement in missions. *Heritage is thankful for the support of the GO Centre.*

DEVELOP A CAREER SERVICES CENTRE (\$75,000)

To better serve our students and alumni, we envision launching a ministry and career services department to assist current students and graduates in ministry and job placement. *We praise God for His provision for this project.*

LAUNCH HERITAGE SEMINARY PRESS (\$60,000)

To strengthen ministry leaders, we are launching Heritage Seminary Press, with Dr. Michael Haykin as the general editor. Each year we will produce biblically solid, ministry-oriented books written by members of our faculty. *Praise God for providing for this initiative.*



GETTING THE WORD OUT ABOUT HERITAGE (\$240,000)

To increase the number of ministry leaders we train, we will actively get the word out about Heritage. We will also endeavour to enlarge our ministry partnerships with local churches and supportive individuals. *We praise God that the funds for this project have already been provided.*

VP OF MINISTRY PARTNERS AND INTERNSHIPS FOR THREE YEARS (\$180,000)

Godfrey Thorogood was hired in January 2021 to serve in this role. The Ministry Partners part of his role sees him connecting with pastors, churches, donors, alumni, foundations and corporations to build relationships, support and encourage churches and help raise support for our capital campaign and our operational budget.


