## **Life and Thought of Jonathan Edwards with Dr. Michael Haykin**

This course is a detailed study of certain aspects of the theology of Jonathan Edwards (1703–1758), who has been well described as “the greatest Christian theologian of the eighteenth century” (Miklós Vetö) and “America’s Augustine.” This course looks first at the contours of the life of Edwards, his marriage and his family. Then, his preaching and mentoring, his teaching on revival, conversion, and true spirituality, as well as the atonement and the Trinity, are considered. His inconsistent thinking regarding slavery is also examined in the course. Finally, something of his legacy in New England and England is discussed via the writings of his mentee Samuel Hopkins and the Edwardsean Baptist theologian Andrew Fuller.
